





Creating a "safe zone" to facilitate property transactions arranged online by members of our community







Online social media buy and sell programs, such as Facebook Marketplace and Kijiji, to name a couple, are often used as platforms to sell stolen goods to unsuspecting purchasers and can potentially cause a threat to safety.





The OPP realize these online buy and sell platforms are also used by criminals for fraudulent transactions. Many purchasers are unaware they are being defrauded until it's too late







By creating a "community safety zone" in Middlesex County OPP detachment parking lots, it moves online transactions away from secluded parking lots or private residences and brings them into a public place.







Project Safe Trade – Parking Space





As an effort to increase public safety and reduce crime, the OPP is inviting members of the public to use OPP detachment parking lots to facilitate online transactions





The role of police:

- Under normal circumstances there will be no police intervention.
- Officers will not mediate private transactions, will not provide documentation and will not be a witness to a transaction. However, should one of the parties request an officer, one will respond.
- Officers will only intervene if the transaction becomes a bylaw, provincial or criminal matter
