

THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX

BY-LAW #7286

A BY-LAW to approve and authorize the Warden and the Clerk to execute an Agreement between Merrymount Family Support and Crisis Care, being the service provider of the “Mutual Aid Parenting Program for Parents and Children (MAPP)” and the Corporation of the County of Middlesex to services to low-income families with respect to participation in the County of Middlesex’s “Middlesex Supports” Program.

WHEREAS:

- A. Council adopted a recommendation on June 25, 2024 to enter into agreements with community partners for April 1, 2024 to March 31, 2025 with respect to participation in the County of Middlesex’s “Middlesex Supports” Program.
- B. Section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;
- C. Section 9 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act; and
- D. Section 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the County of Middlesex enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Agreement between Merrymount Family Support and Crisis Care and the Corporation of the County of Middlesex, attached as Schedule “A”, be approved.
- 2. That the Warden and the County Clerk be hereby authorized to sign and enact the Agreement between Merrymount Family Support and Crisis Care and the Corporation of the County of Middlesex, attached hereto as Schedule “A”.
- 3. That this By-law will come into force and take effect on June 25, 2024.
