- 320 Speeding
- 30 Seatbelt
- 6 Distracted Driving
- 22 Stunt/Racing
- 530 other traffic related charges
- 11 Impaired Driving
- 55 Motor Vehicle Collisions

Numerous drivers were stopped, educated and warned for various driving offences and infractions.

"Traffic safety is always a key focus of Middlesex County officers, however during summer long weekends, the OPP realize an above average number of drivers take to the roads and highways. Many collisions, resulting in serious injury and death occur during these times.
