Subject: Middlesex County Warden's Activity Report – Q1

BACKGROUND:

The Municipal Act, 2001, generally outlines the role of Warden to:

- Act as chief executive officer of the municipality;
- Preside over council meetings;
- Provide leadership to the council;
- Represent the municipality at official functions; and,
- Carry out the duties of the head of council under this or any other Act.

The purpose of the Warden's Activity Report is to formally provide an overview of the Warden's government and community relations activities, achievements, projects and engagements on behalf of Middlesex County.

During this reporting period, the Warden's activities consisted of a mix of political, community, and internal organizational engagements. These activities included meetings with elected representatives and various levels of governance and participation in events such as the London & Middlesex Local Immigration partnership "All Are Welcome Here" event. The schedule also includes regular communication and planning meetings internally with the County staff, the CAO, and different committees.

At the ROMA Conference, Middlesex County's advocacy efforts included delegations with various ministries and officials, including the Ministry of Transportation, Ministry of Infrastructure, Ministry of Long-Term Care and the Ministry of Health. During these meetings, the County emphasized important community issues such as long-term care, community transportation, rural connectivity by addressing cellular and broadband gaps and ambulance offload delays.

The activities of the Warden are conducted in accordance with the broad direction of Council and in alignment with the Middlesex County Strategic Plan and its Guiding Principles:
