

THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX

BY-LAW #7133

A BY-LAW to Authorize the Execution of an Ontario Transfer Payment Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of the Province of Ontario as Represented by the Minister of Infrastructure with the Corporation of the County of Middlesex for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP).

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to authorize the execution of an Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of the Province of Ontario as Represented by the Minister of Infrastructure with the Corporation of the County of Middlesex for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP).

WHEREAS section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS section 9 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS section 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

Now Therefore, The Council of The Corporation of The County of Middlesex hereby enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Warden and the County Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the County of Middlesex an Ontario Transfer Payment Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in Right of the Province of Ontario as Represented by the Minister of Infrastructure with the Corporation of the County of Middlesex for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP).
2. THAT the Warden and the County Clerk have delegated authority to execute any and all required documentation on behalf of The Corporation of the County of Middlesex as required by the Ontario Transfer Payment Agreement.
3. THAT The Corporation of the County of Middlesex commits to spending the Ontario Transfer Payment in accordance with all provisions specified in the Agreement.
