**Subject:** Strathmere Lodge Monthly Census Report for April 2025

### BACKGROUND:

The Lodge collects, reports and monitors various administrative, financial and clinical data. Various data are required to be reported externally, notably to the Ministry of Long Term Care.

### ANALYSIS:

The following data show that The Lodge maintains a high occupancy level, ensuring that access to long term care beds is provided to those awaiting beds as beds become available.

Demand for our one (1) respite ("short stay") bed, designed to provide caregivers at home a reprieve from caring for loved ones at home, has climbed back up further to the COVID-19 pandemic short stay bed closure.
