

2025 Strathmere **Lodge Budget**

2025 Lodge Budget Revenue Sources \$21,638,787



- Middlesex County (19.54%)Residents (20.93%)
- Province of Ontario (58.87%)Other (0.19%)
- WSIB Reserve (0.14%)
- Capital Reserve (0.33%)

Per Diem:

• \$13.07/bed/day

Nutritional Support (Food)



Program Details:

- 3 meals/day
- 3 snacks/day



- \$13.07 x 160 beds x 365 days
 - \$763,288



Programs & Support Services (Recreation)



Per Diem:

• \$12.90/bed/day



Program Details:

- Recreation Staffing & Supplies
- Contracted Entertainers
- Contracted Physiotherapist



- \$12.90 x 160 beds x 365 days
 - \$753,360

Nursing & Personal Care



Per Diem:

\$110.41/bed/day

Program Details:



- Nursing Staffing
 - Personal Support Workers (PSWs)
 - Registered Practical Nurses (RPNs)
 - Registered Nurses (RNs)
- Clinical Care Supplies



- \$110.41 x 160 beds x 365 days x CMI (1.0100) __middlesex
 - \$6,512,423

Case Mix Index (CMI)

- Used by the Ministry of Long-Term Care in calculating the Nursing & Personal Care Envelope for each of Ontario's 630 long-term care homes
 - Unique to each home, based on resident care needs
 - Reflects the resources required to provide care
 - Derived from quarterly health assessments of all residents
 - Residents are grouped into 34 Resource Utilization Groups (RUGs), each with an associated CMI
- Example:
 - "Extensive Services" RUG: CMI as high as 1.9422
 - "Reduced Physical Functions" RUG: CMI as low as 0.6306

Other Accommodations



Per Diem:

\$64.48/bed/day



Program Details:

- Support Services
 - Dietary
 - Housekeeping
 - Laundry
 - Administration
 - Utilities Facility Maintenance



- \$64.48 x 160 beds x 365 days
 - \$3,765,632





Per Diem:

\$7.79/bed/day



Program Details:

- May be apportioned to any funding envelope subject to limits
 - i.e. 32% max to Other
 Accommodations envelope



Annualized Funding Calculator:

- \$7.79 x 160 beds x 365 days
 - o \$454,936



Global Funding

Supplemental – Direct Care Funding



2025-2026 Per Diem:

- \$1,822.02/bed/12 month Nursing
- \$168.74/bed/12 month Allied Health Professionals



Program Details:

- The Province made a 4-year commitment to increase funding for direct care by March 2025
 - 4 hours per resident per day Nursing
 - 36 minutes per resident per day –
 Allied Health Professionals



- \$1,822.02 x 160 beds x 12 months
 - \$3,498,278
- \$168.74 x 160 beds x 12 months
 - o \$323,980



Other Funding Sources

- Comprehensive Minor Capital Fund \$183,328
- Integrated Technology Solutions Program \$65,992
- Resident Health & Well-Being Program \$14,189
- Supporting Professional Growth Fund \$20,947
- IPAC Lead \$81,439
- IPAC Personnel \$40,032
