

THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX

BY-LAW #7136

A BY-LAW to authorize the Warden and the Clerk to execute a Boundary Road Agreement between The Corporation of the County of Middlesex and The Corporation of the County of Huron with respect to road maintenance for the period November 15, 2021 to November 14, 2031.

WHEREAS the parties are adjoining municipalities and are desirous of entering into an agreement under the provisions of Sections 8(1) and 29(1) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, and amendments thereto dealing with the maintenance and repair of boundary roads between such municipalities.

WHEREAS Subsection 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001 provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 5(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001 provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the County of Middlesex deems it expedient to execute a Boundary Road Agreement for this purpose between The Municipality of Corporation of the County of Middlesex and The Corporation of the County of Huron.

THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the County of Middlesex enacts as follows:

1. That the Warden and the Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Boundary Road Agreement between The Corporation of the County of Middlesex and The Corporation of the County of Huron, for the period November 15, 2021 to November 14, 2031, as set out in *Schedule A* attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, providing for the road maintenance;
