## **BUDGET COMMITTEE**

The Budget Committee of Middlesex County Council met between February 9 and March 9, 2023. The budget that was presented to the budget committee was developed taking into account a number of financial and operational pressures including inflation, uncertainty around federal and provincial funding, recruitment challenges, rising interest rates, growth, and supply chain delays.

The draft budget that was presented to the Budget Committee had a tax rate increase of 22.12%. The committee and management worked together to reduce the tax rate to 8.41%.

The following chart outlines the recommendations made. The draft budget has been updated to reflect these changes.
