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1. CALL TO ORDER AND WARDEN'S REMARKS

Warden Burghardt-Jesson called the meeting to order at 1:00pm and addressed Council as follows:

'We acknowledge that the land we stand upon today is the traditional territory of the Attawandaron (Add-a-won-da-run), Anishinabeg (Ah-nish-in-a-beg), Haudenosaunee (Hoden-oh-show-nee), and Lunaapeewak (Len-ahpay-wuk) peoples who have long standing relationships to the land, water and region of Southwestern Ontario. The local First Nation communities of this area include Chippewas of the Thames First Nation, Oneida Nation of the Thames First Nation, and Munsee-Delaware Nation.

We acknowledge the treaties that are specific to this area: Treaty 2 (McKee Purchase), Treaty 3 (Between the Lakes Purchase), Treaty 6 (London Township Purchase), Treaty 21 (Long Woods Purchase) and Treaty 29 (Huron Tract Purchase). We value the significant contributions, both in the past and the present of local and regional first nations of Turtle Island.

We acknowledge historic and ongoing injustices that indigenous peoples endure in Canada and we affirm our commitment to honouring indigenous voices,

nations and cultures, and to moving forward in the spirit of reconciliation and respect.

Did you know this week is National Public Works Week? It's a week dedicated to recognizing Public Works Departments across Canada and the US. This week can be used to educate, engage and inform the community about the essential role these departments play in our quality of life. Equally important is the opportunity to promote Public Works as a career choice. At the County level we can take this opportunity to recognize the work of our Roads and Engineering department. This year's theme is "Connecting the World Through Public Works." This theme highlights the way public works professionals connect us physically through our infrastructure. Through the Roads department, Middlesex and our local municipalities are connected with safe, reliable infrastructure.

This week is also Paramedic Services Week. The theme being celebrated this year is Diversity in Paramedicine – The Patient, The Provider, The Profession. Our communities are constantly changing as is our community of paramedics. This theme allows us to focus on the opportunities within paramedicine related to diversity, equity and inclusion. Our paramedics and those they serve have diverse needs and backgrounds, by building an inclusive and equitable profession the capacity for exceptional care will continue to grow."
