THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX

BY-LAW #7238

A BY-LAW to enter into an agreement with Merrymount Family Support and Crisis Care, being the service provider of the "Mutual Aid Parenting Program for Parents and Children (MAPP)" to provide services to low-income families with respect to participation in the County of Middlesex's "Middlesex Supports" Program for April 1, 2023 to March 31, 2024.

WHEREAS

- A. Council adopted a recommendation on June 20, 2023 to enter into the agreements with community partners for April 1, 2023 to March 31, 2024 with respect to participation in the County of Middlesex's "Middlesex Supports" Program.
- B. Section 5(3) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipal power shall be exercised by bylaw;
- C. Section 9 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act; and
- D. Section 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the County of Middlesex enacts as follows:

1. That the following Agreement be approved:

Merrymount Family Support and Crisis Care operating as "Mutual Aid Parenting Program for Parents and Children (MAPP)" to provide services to low-income families with respect to participation in the County of Middlesex's "Middlesex Supports" Program for the period April 1, 2023 to March 31, 2024, attached as Schedule "A".

2. That the Warden and the County Clerk be hereby authorized and directed to execute the said Agreement.
